## Abstract

This study characterizes the relationship between the response and covariates for zeroinflated data with spatiotemporal correlations. To avoid the uncertainty of the unknown underlying spatiotemporal correlation structure, our research assumes the marginal distribution of the response follows a Hurdle Poisson distribution. We propose an estimation procedure for regression coefficients based on Generalized Estimating. Equations (GEE), incorporating spatiotemporal correlation functions. The spatiotemporal correlation parameters in the working correlation matrix are iteratively estimated non-parametrically. Moreover, the variance of the regression coefficients is estimated using jackknife resampling for subsequent inferences. Simulation experiment results demonstrate our proposed method's effectiveness, showcasing reliable regression coefficient estimates.
